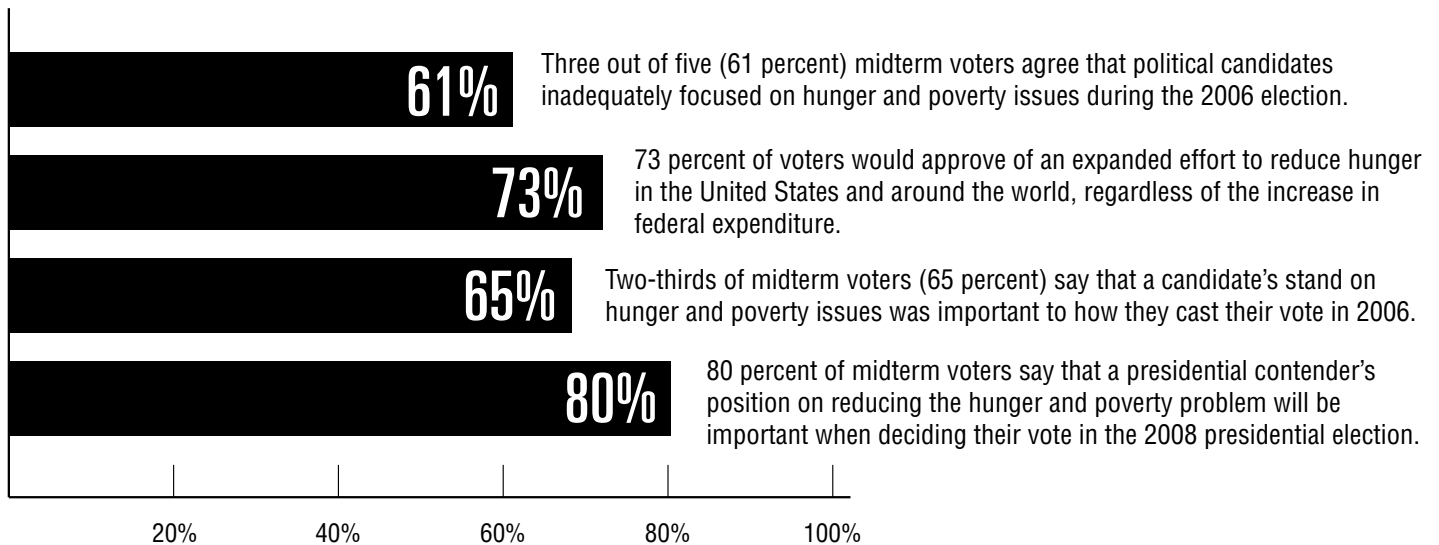


Hunger in the Midterm Elections
